§ **Mountain Valley Beauty: Artists Views of Marshall County** – Artwork and photography that features scenes of Marshall County. April 3 – May 15, 2004.

Deadline for entries is March 12, 2004. Cash awards for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Place. For details, contact the Mountain Valley Arts Council, 300 Gunter Ave. Guntersville, Ala. 35976. (256) 582-1454

Contest is for adult artists; open to all 2- and 3-dimensional artists and photographers. Artwork can be for sale. MVAC will take commissions off sales as follows: MVAC members-20%, non-MVAC-members-30%. Submitted artwork should reflect the theme "Mountain Valley Beauty: Artist Views of Marshall County" - artwork and photography that features scenes of Marshall County. All media will be considered. Artwork must have been completed within the last 5 years. Size limit on 2-dimensional art is 48" in any direction. 3-dimensional work must be of a size that one person may move easily and safely. Submission may be in the following formats: slides; photos (up to 8x10); JPEG or other digital formats. We do not have the space to store original work during the jurying process. Accepted 2-dimensional work must be framed with a wire hanging system. Our gallery does not support any other type of hangers (saw tooth, cardboard tabs, etc.). Canvas pieces do not have to be framed if they are finished and show no bare canvas. They must, however, have a wire installed for hanging. Even if a piece has been accepted, it will not be hung or be eligible for judging if these requirements are not met!!!

Deadline for entries: March 12, 2004

Artists notified: March 19, 2004

Accepted work delivered to gallery: March 29, 2004

Show opens: April 3, 2004

Artists' Reception and Award Ceremony: April 12, 2004

Show ends: May 15, 2004

Pick up work: May 17-19, 2004

Artists will be charged \$2 a day storage fee for artwork not picked up by May 29, 2004

Jury fee: \$25 for up to three submissions.

Additional submissions: \$10 each. Submission cannot be processed until jury fees are paid.

should be able to include a train ride with a steam engine, and finish up the day at the River Garden, a beautiful private property with wonderful spring wildflowers. Sunday morning we will go to Lula Lake Land Trust, another private property. This workshop will not be repeated in 2005.
